### **Kristu Jayanti School of Management National Webinar on The Big IPO Boom – Who is Winning**

The School of Management of Kristu Jayanti College (Autonomous), Bengaluru organised a National Webinar on the Nation's trending topic 'The Big IPO Boom – Who is Winning' to capture the recent big moves of new-age companies listing themselves on the stock market. The webinar held on 22nd September had Dr Aloysius Edward, Dean, Faculty of Commerce and Management of Kristu Jayanti College as the resource person for the day. The Dean was accompanied by Rev Dr Fr Augustine George, Principal, Kristu Jayanti College (Autonomous), Dr M.K Baby, Head, School of Management and Dr Sripriya T.P, the coordinator of the webinar.
