Brief Write up on the Programme:

This is a brief report about the Aptitude Training classes which were provided to the first year MBA/PGDM students as a part of the curriculum itself, which is very necessary to clear the Interview process. The training was conducted be a team of faculty members from Career Launcher. The sessions were conducted for 3-4 days a week from 3 to 5:50 pm as per the schedule and the students were divided into 2 batches. The introductory sessions was for about 3 days and were conducted by Mr. Anil Nair, the founder of Career Launcher, a renowned aptitude trainer who briefed the students about topics like speed calculations, mental maths, and also enriched the students with many shortcut techniques which are useful to solve many aptitude problems within a short period of time.

The further sessions were conducted by various other faculties from Career Launcher who covered the topics from Quantitative, Logical Reasoning and Verbal part of Aptitude. The Quantitative topics covered include Time and Work, Time, Speed and Distance, Profit& Loss, Ratio and many more. In Verbal reasoning, the students were thought about the basics of English grammar, Comprehension, parajumbles etc. In Logical Reasoning the students were taught about topics like Seating arrangement, Blood Relations, Analogy, Number series etc, which are very relevant to clear the aptitude test.

The students were also provided with an online portal where they were asked to take online tests on a regular basis and scores were provided which was a very good step taken for the improvement of students and also helpful towards their self-assessment.
